## **Registration**

Registration procedures vary by assessment. Inquiries regarding registration may be made directly to the Assessment Center at (573) 334-0826, extension 6509.

Payment for assessments must be made in advance of the testing date. Payment can be made:

- in person with check, cash, or debit/credit card,
- by mail with personal check, or
- by phone with a debit/credit card.

## **Refunds**

Notice of cancellation must be received at least 24 hours prior to the testing date for a full refund; a late cancel/rescheduling fee of \$10 will be applied after this time period. The testing fee is non-refundable past the testing date.
